







Intent of Firearm Deaths Among US Teenagers (Ages 15-19), 2014-2017



- Unintentional


N=9,803 (known intent only)

HOPE IS NOT A STRATEGY



- 1) Identifying decision makers
 - Reaching out to governors
- 2) Building coalitions & set goal
 - Medical societies
 - Child health groups
- 3) Mobilizing members
 - Quick and intentional action
- 4) Craft a message and speaking out
 - Pragmatic boldness, pick battles
 - Be first, be right, be credible

WHY ARE STORIES IMPORTANT TO ADVOCACY?

- Humanize: Put a face to an issue
- Illustrate: Paint a picture of how an issue impacts real children and families
- Relatable: We put ourselves in the shoes of that person
- Memorable: More than just a number or statistic
